

After-School Social Skills Classes

Group 1: Students ages 8-10 meets Mondays from 2:30 - 3:30

Classes will focus on friendship making with an emphasis on skills like introducing yourself, beginning and ending a conversation, joining in a group, playing a game, and offering help to a classmate.



Group 2: Students ages 11-14 meets Mondays from 3:45 - 4:45

Classes will focus on social comprehension and problem-solving with an emphasis on reading others and the environment, using a friendly and respectful voice, respecting others' boundaries, understanding differences, and planning for stressful situations.
